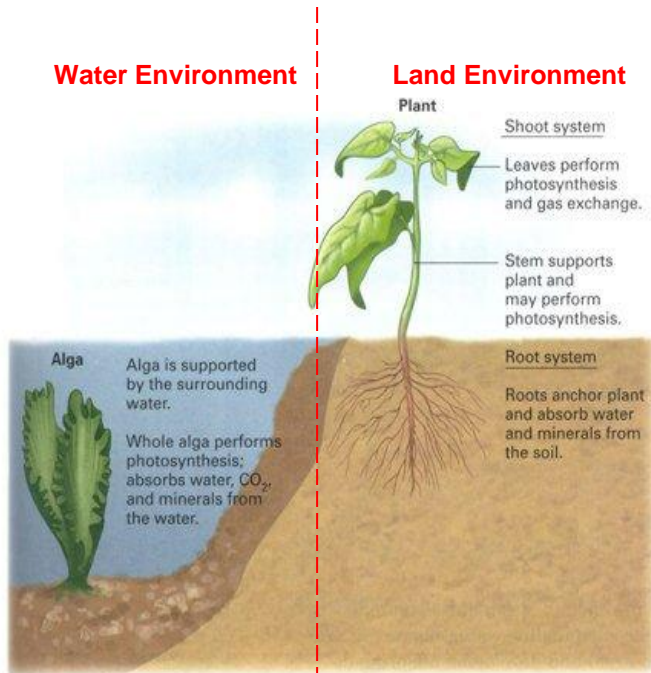

The plants developed adaptations to help it survive in the different environments in which it was living.

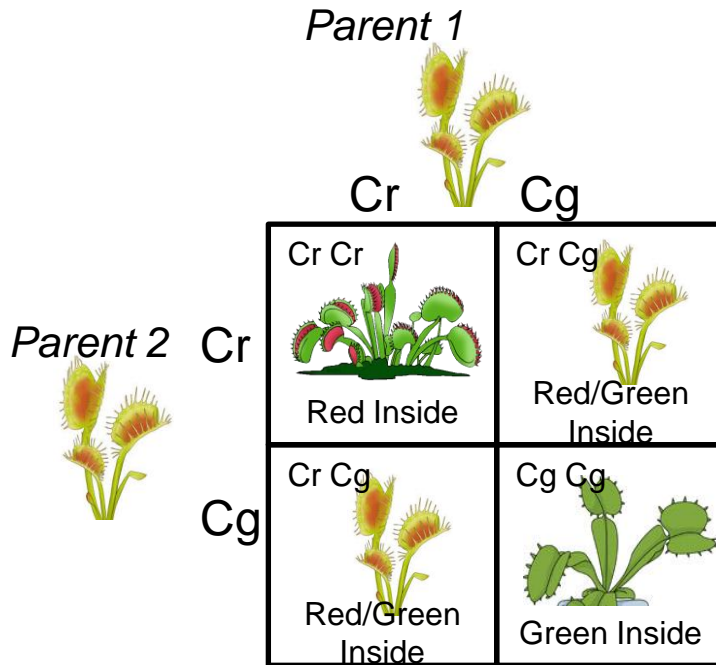

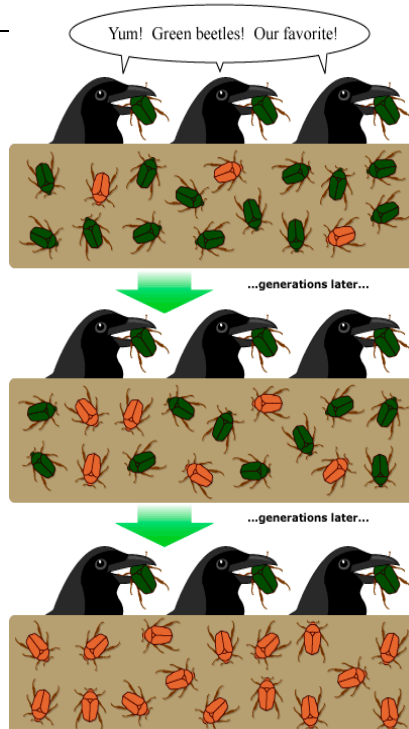
## DEFINITION

The process by which any characteristic of an individual that allows it to survive to produce more offspring will eventually appear in every individual of the species, simply because those members will have more offspring
